Tourette's Disorder

If your 6- to 17-year-old child has Tourette's disorder, please consider our clinical research study for aripiprazole. Aripiprazole is currently approved by the FDA for the treatment of Tourette's disorder in children, and this study will help us learn more about its long-term safety and effectiveness.

Children with schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, or certain other psychiatric or mood disorders are not eligible for this research study. Other criteria will be reviewed to determine if your child may participate. Participation lasts up to 10 months and requires about 17 visits to the research clinic. Qualified participants will receive study-related procedures and study drug at no cost. Reimbursement may be provided for study-related travel.
